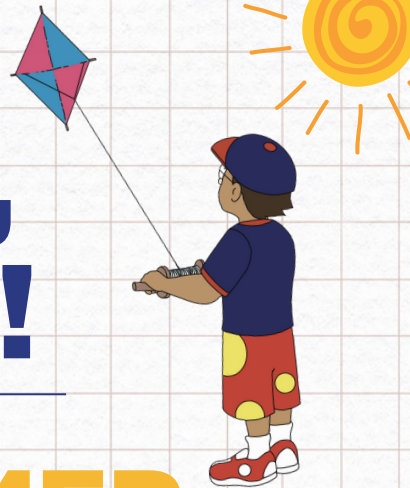


BIG BOOKS, BY GEORGE!

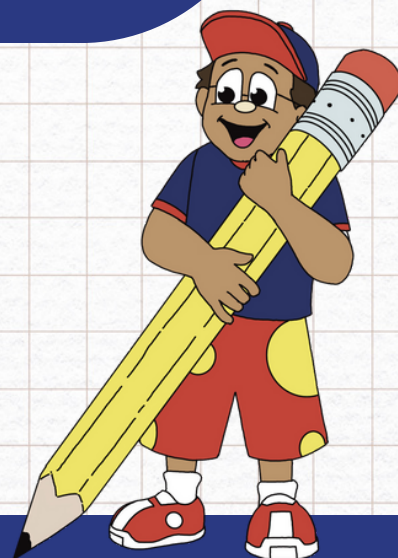
